

Clytemnestra: Tangled Justice

A One Woman show with Courtney Walsh

This intense 40-minute performance featuring Michael Keck's dynamic score focuses on the dramatic figure of Clytemnestra in Aeschylus' *Oresteia*. The character dazzles us with her verbal power and theatrical daring, raising questions about political justice, gender parity, sexual jealousy, blood loyalty, and the compulsions of war.

Following the performance, a discussion with Walsh and translator/director Rush Rehm of Stanford University invites the audience to engage with this powerful character and the intractable issues she raises.
